

Admission Post-Kidney Transplant

When admitting a patient who has previously received a kidney transplant, your facility must choose one of the following admit reasons in CROWNWeb:

	Dialysis in Support of Transplant	Dialysis After Transplant Failed
Step 1 Admission	<p><i>Does the patient require temporary kick-start dialysis?</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use Dialysis in Support of Transplant if the transplanted kidney needs temporary/kick-start dialysis support. <p><i>* This should not be used if the patient's transplant has completely failed.</i></p>	<p><i>Has the transplanted kidney completely failed?</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use Dialysis After Transplant Failed if the transplanted kidney is non-functioning and the patient requires a permanent course of dialysis. <p><i>* Do not use this option if the patient's native kidney failed.</i></p>
Step 2 Transient	<p>The patient must be admitted as a <i>Transient</i>, with <i>Transient Reason: Dialysis in Support of Transplant.</i></p>	<p>Only select <i>Transient</i> if the patient transferred to another dialysis facility within 30 days of being admitted into your dialysis facility.</p>
Step 3 2728	<p>No 2728 form is required.</p>	<p>A Re-entitlement 2728 form is required only if the patient's transplant was performed three or more years prior to the admission into your facility.</p>
Step 4 Discharge	<p>When the transplanted kidney regains function, you may discharge the patient as:</p> <p>Transfer: Dialysis Facility</p>	<p>Please update the Network with the patient's CROWN UPI so that we may update the previous transplant record:</p> <p>Data@nw18.esrd.net</p>
