

# ESRD Network 18 Transplant Living Donor Criteria

All Living Kidney Donor candidates must complete the physical and psychologic evaluation to determine risks and safety of procedure.

This is not an exhaustive list of eligibility criteria. Please contact transplant center for more information about exclusions determined on a case by case bases.

\* Some Transplant Centers will accept recipients with HIV, HEP C or other transmissible disease. Contact transplant center for questions about variance.
